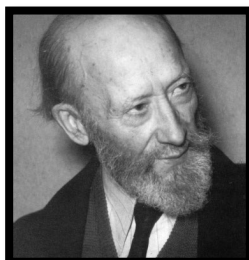

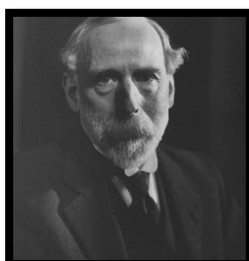

Ozias Leduc

Ozias Leduc (1864–1955) was one of Quebec’s most important painters. He was born three years before the signing of the British North America Act and died just as the signs of the Quiet Revolution were beginning to appear. He was born in Saint-Hilaire-de-Rouville. Leduc produced many portraits, still lifes and landscapes, as well as religious works.



Homer Watson

Homer Ransford Watson (January 14, 1855 – May 30, 1936) was a Canadian landscape painter. He was a member and president of the Royal Canadian Academy of Arts, as well as a founding member and first president of the Canadian Art Club. Although Watson had almost no formal training, by the mid-1920s he was well known and admired by Canadian collectors and critics.



Living Loving Local Strawberry Month



The first fruit of summer, strawberries are traditionally in season for a few weeks in June/July then again in September thanks to the Day-Neutral variety of strawberry.

Sweet, succulent, juicy and delicious strawberries have been cultivated since the 13th century, although fossil evidence suggests that wild strawberries existed in pre-historic times. Delicious in sweet or savoury recipes, strawberries have got to be one of the most popular local foods available. We typically treat strawberries as fruit, but they are actually the enlarged end of the plant's stamen, hence more of a flower.
