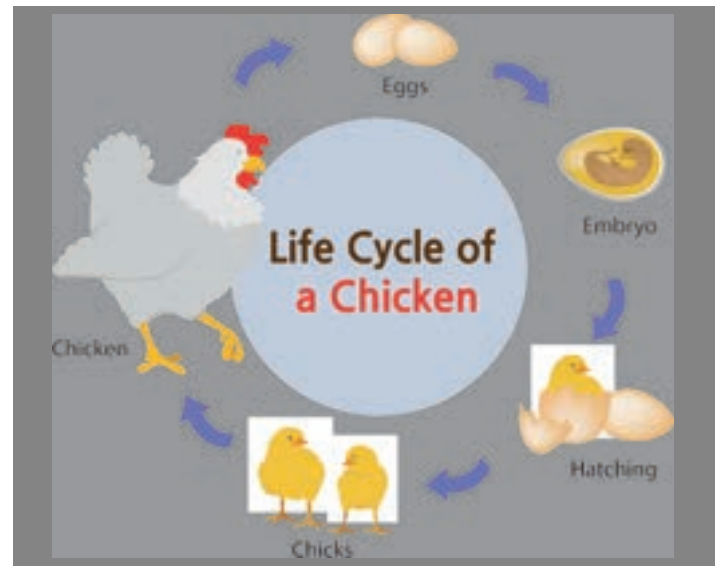


Words from Malisha, Director of Care

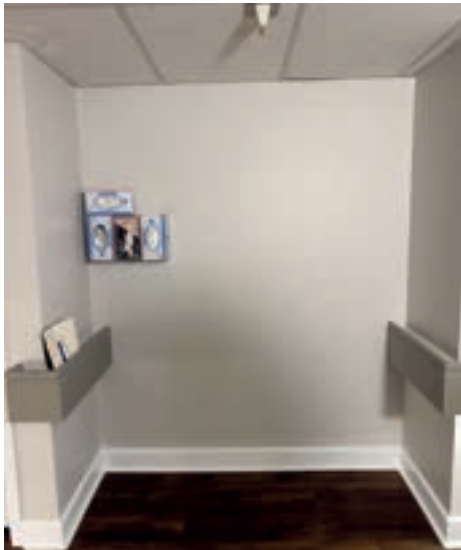
